## RENAISSANCE BEGINNINGS

### 1. WEALTH of Italian cities

- Italy was the "CRADLE OF THE RENAISSANCE"
- \$\$\$\$\$ thru Trade / Banking
- "MAGIC Triangle" Genoa, Venice, Florence
  - where Renaissance began
- City-states also competed for art / artists

## 2. Large number of URBAN areas

Ideas spread much quicker

## 3. Rise in UNIVERSITIES

- people wanted to LEARN
- when literacy increases, people begin to ASK questions

## IDEAS OF THE RENAISSANCE

### 1. HUMANISM




