Science has given us nylon, fluoride, latex paint ,747s, faster microchips and PEZ


BUT science has also given us fluorocarbons, heroin, nuclear waste, dioxin, sarin gas and the atomic bomb!!!



GALILEO '

- **TELESCOPE**
 - enemy ships
 - used to prove Copernicus and Heliocentric Theory correct
 - Church did <u>not</u> agree

- 1632 Galileo wrote "Dialogue"
 - imaginary conversation between 3 characters
 - Character 1 supported Galileo's side of the argument
 - ➤ Character 2 was open to both sides of the argument
 - Character 3 (Simplicio) gave Pope Urban VIII's arguments against Galileo and for "geo-centrism"

Pope Urban VIII ordered Galileo to stand trial for "HERESY"

Church felt Galileo's scientific discoveries contradicted the Catholic **interpretation** of Christian scripture

□human observation and reasoning that differs from the Church MUST be wrong

GALILEO cont.

- Galileo pointed out that he was <u>not</u> denying God's perfection or role as a creator
 - HE WAS NOT SAYING GOD WAS WRONG, but the interpretation by the Church was wrong
- Church held that knowledge was revealed in Scripture and that the Clergy were the only ones allowed to interpret Scripture
 - So...SHUT UP AND I WILL TELL YOU WHAT I WANT YOU TO KNOW

GALILEO cont.

CHURCH FEARED THAT IF ITS TEACHINGS/BELIEFS WERE CALLED INTO QUESTION, THEN ALL OF ITS TEACHINGS COULD BE QUESTIONED

- Galileo, now 68, avoided torture by recanting and accepting house arrest
- o after recanting Galileo whispered, "and yet it moves"

10/31/1992 **Pope John Paul II** apologized and cleared Galileo of any wrongdoing

RENE DESCARTES

Argued that at the very essence of a human being was the ability to think or reason

- "I THINK THEREFORE I AM"
- BUT had to prove without offending the Church
- He argued that the Church could not deny reason because it had been given to us by God
 - only by reason can we have an idea of God, understand scripture, worship, etc...
 - "all our ideas or notions ought to have some foundation of truth, for it
 would not be possible that God, who is all-perfect and all-truthful,
 would have put them in us without that"
